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




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(SMART living) Spokane, WA

This rehabilitation center will be following and inspired by the "SMART" recovery model. It was founded in 1994. SMART stands for (self-management and recovery training). It is a non-12-step program, however, it is focused on self-empowerment, where the program teaches skills for self-directed change and assists patients to cope with urges and manage thought, feelings, and behaviors that can drive to addiction. The main concept behind this design is the rethinking of the design of the rehabilitation center. This rehabilitation center will contains different therapies programs that can help the patients to find their motivation to have a meaningful and successful recovery such as recreation center, yoga, dance room art and painting room music room, individual and group counseling rooms.









The design seeks to provide an environment which will expedite the recovery of patients through the creation of the following:




Goals




Housing: rendered view of the shared living space, encouraging residents to communicate by providing a welcoming environment.









Option 1: Single bedroom w/ shared bathroom








Option 2: Shared bedroom w/ shared bathroom

The city of Pullman, Washington has always been a wonderful place to live. Visitors and residents come for the small-town feel, thriving agriculture, employment, and education opportunities. The WSU campus takes up a large portion of town, while the main downtown entrance of Pullman guides you right up to it. 

The design promotes pedestrian spaces and safety through developed areas. New paths and walkways create a sense of path and place for users to appreciate during a journey from campus to town.




Community




















Vertical circulation between floors.




